Reading

In October, we will read stories about animals and their basic needs. The students will be retelling stories, including key details, and demonstrating understanding of their central message or lesson. They will also describe characters, settings, and major events in a story, using key details. Students just finished with BOY reading 3D assessments. A report will be sent home soon.

Math

We will practice counting and writing to 50. Students should be able to count forward from any number about 5-7 more numbers (e.g. 78, 79, 80, 81, 82, 83). Then, we will work on using addition and subtraction to solve word problems to 10.

Science

We will study force and motion understanding how forces (pushes or pulls) affect the motion of an object. Students will recognize the features and patterns of the earth/moon/sun system as observed from Earth.
