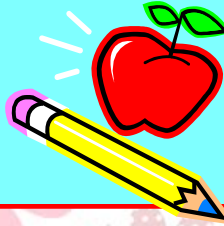

If your child receives a green that means that they had a SUPER Day with no behavioral issues.

If your child receives a yellow that means that they had a O.K. Day with minimal behavioral issues.

If your child receives a red that means that they need to think before they react.

If your child receives a orange that means that they had to go to the chill down station to calm themselves.

If your child receives a blue that means that your child had a rough day and need to have positive behavioral intervention support from a teacher and/or teacher aide.
